



Fayette County Art Contest

Create a colorful picture based on the 2009 Earth Day Theme “Water in Our World” and enter the Fayette County Art Contest.

Guidelines

1. Open to K-12 students in Fayette County.
2. Create a colorful picture based on the 2009 Earth Day Theme “Water in Our World”. Your art must be on paper no larger than 11" X 14" oriented in a landscape format.
 - a. Natural topics only.
 - b. Any image form of drawing or painting is acceptable.
 - c. Any form related to water; streams, rivers, lakes, oceans, etc.
 - d. Do not use any specific scenery; however, bridges, boats or other water-related objects that are man-made are acceptable.
3. Crayons, markers, ink, colored pencils, or poster paint may be used. Please do not use glue, glitter, or any other materials that create texture.
4. Include your name, grade, teacher, school and contact information on the reverse of your entry.
5. All artwork must be delivered to East Fayette Elementary School (245 Booker Ave, Fayetteville, Georgia 30215) by Friday, March 20, 2009.

Judging

Only five (5) entries will be accepted from each school or education group. These entries will be judged by a select committee prior to Earth Day.

During the Earth Day celebration, attendees will be asked to judge the top 25 entries. The “Best of Category” will be chosen for the elementary, middle and high school level. The artwork that receives the greatest number of votes on Earth Day will be recognized as the Grand Prize winner. Part of the Grand Prize award will be the use of the art on T-shirts for a county-wide stream cleanup in October as a part of Georgia Rivers Alive.
